Obituary of John Panzetta

John Cosmo Panzetta, Sr., 72, of Bushnell, FL, died Wednesday, February 12, 2014 at Sumterville, FL. He was born February 22, 1941 in Pulsano, Italy. He was an Ordained Minister with the Assemblies of God and a member of Bushnell Assembly of God. Mr. Panzetta was the prison chaplain at Sumter Correctional Institution from 1979-2012, and during his 33 years there, multiplied thousands of men experienced the love of Jesus through his ministry. He was a graduate of Yale Divinity School (MDIV) and awarded a Doctorate of Divinity from Trinity Christian College in 2011. He was a scholar who always had a book in his hand and was always ready to talk to people about the greatness of our God and the saving power of Jesus.

He is survived by his wife of 43 years, Joanne Panzetta of Bushnell, FL: son, Johnny Cosmo (Rivkah) Panzetta of Surprise, AZ; daughter, Maria Panzetta of Bushnell, FL; grandchildren, Dina, Douglas, Rhiannon, Giovanni, Antonio, Kassiani, Rivkahle, and Raphael; brothers, Angelo (Maria) Panzetta of Pulsano, Italy, Cataldo (Grazie) Panzetta of Pulsano, Italy, and Antonio (Anna) Panzetta of Pulsano, Italy; sisters, Teresa (Giovanni) Pantaleo of Pulsano, Italy, and Epifania Panzetta of Pulsano, Italy.
