John Alan Pringle, 69, of Port Orange, FL passed away on Tuesday, December 4, 2018. Born in Leesburg, FL, he grew up in Leesburg, moved to Cocoa Beach and graduated from Cocoa Beach High School. He served in the Air Force and graduated with his Bachelor's Degree in computer science from UF. John and his dad, George (both avid pilots), took over S.E. Angel Flight (a volunteer pilots' charity transporting the ill and needy all over the country for medical care) and expanded it to five states. He was a volunteer with Lake Co. Deaf and Hearing Services and a volunteer with Volusia County Adult Literacy Program. He received the Jefferson Humanitarian Award. With his father George, he founded Pringle Development in 1981, then sold it to the employees in 2004. He owned Home with Caregivers, Inc. in Daytona Beach and was president of Genuine Dog Care.

He is survived by his wife, Debra Pringle of Port Orange, FL; daughter, Sabrina "Skye" Pringle of Port Orange, FL; mother, Elisabeth Pringle of Orange City, FL and brothers, George Hale (Robyn) Pringle of Altamonte Springs, FL and David Lawrence (Ceridwen) Pringle of Temple Terrace, FL..
