John David Vance, Jr., 86, of Leesburg was born May 15, 1928 in Mason City, Iowa and passed away May 7, 2015. A veteran of the Korean War, he proudly served in the United States Marine Corps. He was a piano tuning technician and owned and operated Vance Piano Service for 40 plus years. He moved to Leesburg from Port Charlotte in 1987 and became an active member of Morrison United Methodist Church. He was a member of the Church Council, choir and the Enquirer's Class. Additionally he was a member of the Masonic Lodge Solomon #36 in Newark, Delaware, American Legion Post in Leesburg, Florida and was Past President of the Leesburg Sunrise Rotary. A beloved father, he is survived by his children: John David Vance, III of Erlanger, KY and Kathryn Vance of Jenkintown, PA. He was preceded in death by his wife of 53 years, Martha in 2003 as well as an infant sister Katherine.
