Obituary of Jon Slaby

Slaby, Jon B., 67, of Leesburg, FL, passed away at home on July 1, 2015. Born in Wilkesburg, PA in 1947 to the late John and Florence Slaby, Jon was a graduate of Geneva College in Beaver Falls, PA, and was a former executive for both Eastalco Aluminum Company in Frederick, MD and Consolidated Natural Gas (now Dominion Resources) in Clarksburg, WV. Having served in the U.S. Army Reserves, Jon believed in giving back to his community: coaching youth soccer, raising funds for public schools, serving as Chairman of the Salvation Army Advisory Board in Clarksburg, WV, volunteering at the Leesburg, FL Salvation Army, and actively participating as a member of Morrison United Methodist Church. He was an avid golfer, a lifelong fan of Pittsburgh sports teams, most notably the Steelers, and a target shooter with the Pennbrooke Pistoleros. He is survived by his wife Jo Anne; son Scot, his wife Marie, and their children Ella and Walt (Thurmont, MD); son Todd (Emeryville, CA); brother Ken, his wife Anne Barrins, and their son Ken (St. Petersburg, FL); niece Summer Desai and her husband, Rohan (Houston, TX); niece Natalie (Saxonburg, PA); nephew Chad McCollum, his wife Colleen, and their son Max (Glen Mills, PA); niece Chasie Haupt, her husband Rick, and their children Pippa and Zoe (Nokomis, FL); many cousins, in-laws, and friends near and far.
