Obituary of Joseph Barr

Joseph T. Barr, Jr., 87, died Monday September 30, 2013. Born January 3, 1926, in NEWARK, NJ, lived and raised his family in Nutley, NJ before relocating to The Villages in 1997. Joe and Beth were Episcopalians and members of St. George Episcopal Church in The Villages and Grace Church, Nutley, NJ.
