Obituary of Joseph Sudano

Joseph R. Sudano, 88, The Villages, FL died Wednesday, September 29, 2010. Mr. Sudano was born in Elwood City, Pennsylvania. He was a member of The Greatest Generation. He joined the Civilian Conservation Corps in 1939. In 1942, he volunteered for The U.S. Army Air Corps and served as a tail gunner on a B-25 bomber. In 1944, during fighting over Italy, he was wounded. After his discharge from the service, he worked for The Veterans Administration, The Public Housing Administration, and for The Department of the Army Armament Command, as a civilian employee. After retirement, he lived for many years in Plantation Florida. Later, following the death of his wife, he moved to The Villages, in 2002. Survivors include: a daughter, Barbara (Mark) Carroll, Miami Shores, Florida; a granddaughter, Elizabeth Anne Carroll, Miami Shores, Florida; and a sister, Rosanna Sciote, Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania. Mr. Sudano was predeceased by: his sister, Rosella Sudano; his parents, Ross and Carmella Sudano; his brothers, Nick and John Sudano (both were WWII Purple Heart recipients); and his wife, Doris Johnson Sudano.
