Obituary of Joshua Faile

Joshua Ryan Faile, 23 of Leesburg was born August 11th, 1990 and departed to Heaven on January 19, 2014.

Joshua was raised in a God fearing home and spent much of his younger years involved in church functions. He grew up in Main Street Baptist Church (now the Genesis Center) and was currently a member of Community United Methodist Church.

Joshua was a 2008 graduate of First Academy, where he was captain of the football team and a member of the debate, tennis, and golf teams.
