Obituary of Judith Paynter

Judith Linda Paynter, 69, Lady Lake, FL passed away on Saturday, February 9, 2013. She was born on March 30, 1943 to Amelia and Linwood Cahall at her home on Catswamp Road in Elkton, MD.

Schools and Lake View Terrace Retirement Center. She went back to school and became an RN at 50 years of age at Waterman Hospital Eustis. She loved to travel, go on mission trips, tell others about the Lord and spend time with her family.

She developed a long term illness that lasted 13 years and went home to be with the Lord Jesus, whom she loved and served, in her sleep surrounded by her loving family.
