Obituary of Julian Moreland

Julian "Shook" Moreland, 90, of Leesburg, FL was born July 28, 1926 in Richmond, VA and passed away January 30, 2017. He was a veteran of the US Army and honorably served his country during WWII and after serving, attended and graduated from Ohio State University. Shook taught high school math and coached in Whitehall, OH as well as worked on the family farm in Johnstown.
