### Obituary of June Beard

Dorothy June Harper Beard was born in Painesville, Ohio on March 22, 1927 to Norman L. and Mary Geraldine Bartholme Harper and grew up in Geneva, Ohio. After graduation from high school she attended Marietta College receiving a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1948.

On August 29, 1954 she married Raymond S. Beard in Cleveland, Ohio. They lived in New York City for four years, moved to Cortland, New York in 1958 and settled in Homer, New York in 1960. Mrs. Beard was active in the Homer Congregational Church and the Faculty Wives Club at SUNY-College at Cortland.

In 1997, Dr. and Mrs. Beard moved to Lady Lake, Florida. Since living in Florida, Mrs. Beard has been an officer in the Puc Puggy Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution; Timucua Chapter of Colonial Dames, XVII Century; local chapter of the Retired Public Employees Association of New York, Central New York Club in The Villages, and The Villages Genealogy Society.

She is survived by her three children: Geraldine S. Beard of Pollock Pines, California; Jeffrey S. Beard (Sheila) of Annandale, Virginia; and Kristen Beard Stetson (Matthew) of Pownal, Maine; four grandsons: Cole and Lucas Stetson of Maine and Ian and Tobias Beard of California; and one sister, Nancy Savelle of Clearwater, Florida. She was preceded in death by her husband of 57 years Raymond S. Beard, and two sisters, Ida Kyler and Norma Inscho.
