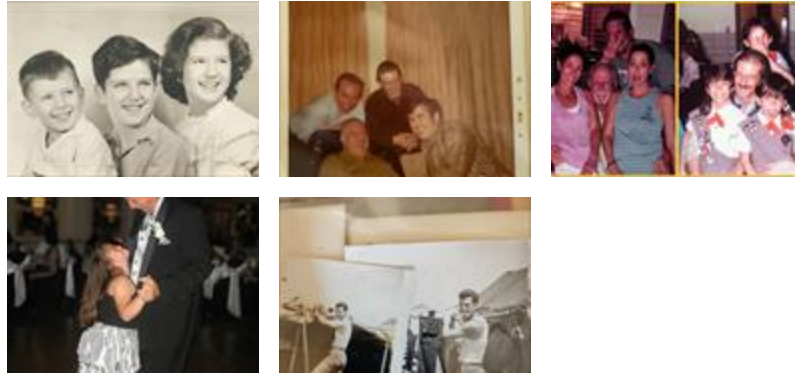
Keith is preceded by his parents, and sister Judy.
