Obituary of Kurt Longenecker

Kurt Roy Longenecker, 62 died Thursday, October 29, 2009 following a long battle with cancer. Mr. Longenecker was born in Washington D.C., moving to Decatur, GA in 1964. He and his wife, Beverly lived in the Mountain Park community of Gwinnett County in Georgia for more than 20 years. He moved to The Villages, FL in 2004 from Monroe, GA and he was a member of the First Baptist Church of Lady Lake. He was a Vietnam Veteran with the US Air Force from 1966-1970. He received his BS degree in Criminal Justice from Georgia State and his early career was spent with local and state agencies, ending as a Special Investigator in the Insurance Industry.

He was predeceased by his parents Roy and Joyce (Thompson) Longenecker.
