### Obituary of L. Geiger

Dow Geiger, Jr, 77 of Leesburg, FL died peacefully at home Friday, December 27, 2013. Dow was born in Tampa, FL to Mertice and LD Geiger and moved to Leesburg in 1946 where he graduated from Leesburg High School and then received his Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture from the University of Florida. Dow was also a member of the ATO Fraternity. He joined the National Guard and later served in the Army Reserves. He was involved in many aspects in the citrus industry including owning a packing house. He stayed in citrus until 1982, then entered real estate where he was a broker and became a commercial appraiser, owning and operating Inland Realty.
