Obituary of Lawrence Lundvall

Lawrence Wilson Lundvall passed away Thursday, August 23, 2012 at his home in Brittany Estates, Leesburg, FL at the age of 95. He was born in New Raymer, Colorado on October 18, 1916. Because of a severe drought in that area the family of two sons and his parents moved to Ft. Collis where his father had a dray business and his mother was a House Mother at the Colorado State University. In 1920 they moved by covered wagon from FT. Collins to Cody, Wyoming. His father had traded his New Raymer farm for a ranch near Cody, Wyoming sight unseen. Lawrence attended a country school and then graduated from Cody High School in 1935, having been a star on the football team. He married Phyllis Ballinger on May 22, 1941 and have been married 71 years. They were farmers and ranchers in Powell, Wyoming for 17 years and then aquired the A&W Root Beer Drive-in at Worland, Wyoming which they operated for 9 years.

Both Lawrence and Phyllis enjoyed sports and saw a lot of the United States as they traveled from game to game watching the Wyoming Cowboys. It was on January 1, 1951 that they traveled to the Gator Bowl to watch Wyoming play Washington and Lee. From December of 1979, they spent their winters at Brittany Estates and were snow birds until 2001 when they moved to Florida. The Lundvalls spent many summers in Wyoming enjoyed watching their

grandchildren and great-grandchildren play sports. He especially enjoyed riding his bike and playing pool with his friends. Lawrence is survived by his wife, Phyllis, his daughter, Bonnie Earhart and husband Neil and his son Larry Lundvall and his wife Kerry all of Wyoming, six grandchildren, fifteen great-grandchildren and two great-great grandsons. He is preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Kenneth Lundvall. Cremation has taken place, a Memorial Service will be held Saturday, August 25th at 9 am at the clubhouse at Brittany Estates.
