Obituary of Leslie Rios

Leslie Gil Rios Jr., 67, of Eustis, Florida, passed away Friday, October 18, 2013. Born in San Luis Obispo of a family that was one of the original land grant families in southern California in 1885, Les graduated with a bachelor's degree from Lake Tahoe College in California where he played basketball on full scholarship. Les loved sports and was recently inducted into the Atascadero High School Hall of Fame in basketball and baseball.

He and his wife, Jo-Ann Stanley, moved to Lake County from California in 1987. Les was one of the founders of Aero Electronics Systems which grew from a start up to a multi-million dollar business. He served as Vice President of Business Development, Marketing and Sales. He was Six Sigma trained. Les loved sports and was active in the Eustis High School baseball program for many years.

Les was the loving brother of his late sister, Pat Bill, and sisters, Pam Clark and Gerry Hetrick.
