Lillie Mae Whitlock, 94, of Umatilla, Florida, passed away on July 3rd, 2024. Her husband Grady Whitlock preceded her in death in 2002.

Mae was born in Carnegie, Georgia in 1930 to William and Maude Monk. The family moved to Florida, where she spent her childhood. Mae attended school in Umatilla when growing up and she had four sisters, Helen (deceased), Mildred, Jeanette (deceased) and Judith who all resided in the Umatilla area.
