After training in the military police, she served in Colorado Springs, Colorado and Seoul South Korea. When her tour of duty was finished Lori returned to Florida and finished her education at Gulf Coast Community College and Florida State University with degrees in Criminal Justice and Criminal Law. Lori spent the next 25 years in the Federal Corrections Department first in Florida then in Cumberland Maryland where she retired in 2014. From a young age Lori had a love of dogs. She was never happier than when she was surrounded by them. Lori enjoyed nature and road trips with her dogs (urchins). She also enjoyed being with family and spending time with her nieces and nephews. After returning to Florida to be close to her family Lori spent her days raising, training and competing with her beloved dogs in agility competitions. “ So many of us are still reeling and heartbroken by the tragedy of Lori's passing. I am so sad that I will not be able to join you all in person on the 20th, but I wanted to share some memories and thoughts about Lori.

I met Lori through dogs and dog training. I knew her slightly during the Boomer (cattle dog) and Chopsticks (doberman) era but really got to know her after she rescued Luke, a big, gawky Doberman from a shelter.

Luke was a challenge. Good hearted but not brilliant nor entirely sound, many trainers would have given up on him. Not Lori. She persisted and he earned his AKC Canine Good Citizenship and Companion Dog titles. She also had the massive Standard poodle/Giant Schnauzer mix, Beau who looked exactly like a Black Russian Terrier and whom Lori absolutely adored.

And, of course, tiny, five pound Bree, the sassy toy poodle who is now thirteen and still full of herself.

Lori got Molly, a ridiculously social and absolutely brilliant border collie 6 years ago and competed successfully with her in obedience, dock diving and, especially agility. Molly is a fabulous dog and I eagerly awaited her first litter to get a Molly puppy. Alas, she had a single beautiful puppy (Icon) that Molly decided was Lori's, not hers so Lori basically raised her, foregoing sleep and everything else. A second breeding of Molly produced another singleton, Hake, who I was lucky enough to get. Again, Lori did the bulk of the puppy raising while Molly sat back and criticized.

Hake came to live with me in Maryland and has been a great joy. It does hurt when he does something cute or funny and I know I cannot share it with Lori, but maybe she knows.

It is a testament to Lori's great love of her dogs that every person who heard of the tragedy of her passing asked "what is happening to the dogs? Are they okay?" Some people might not understand, but I know Lori would. And she would be glad that her dogs were a priority for her family, as they always were for her.

I spent many,many,many hours with Lori talking about dogs, of course, but when we were not talking about dogs she was talking about her wonderful family,and her great love for, and pride in, their accomplishments. I loved hearing her talk about all the things her nieces and nephews were doing and their accomplishments, babies, birthday parties. She loved you all dearly and one tiny thing to be grateful for is that she moved back to Florida and got to spend time with you (and to let her nephew build her porch!)

This has been too long but I do not feel like I have even touched the surface of the ways that Lori's extraordinary life affected so many. I guess I can sum it it up by saying that Lori was the rare person who knew how to be a true friend.
