Obituary of Louise Caddell

Louise Annette (Sturgis) Caddell, 89, of Wildwood, FL went home to be with her Lord on May 6, 2012. She was born October 27, 1922 in Quincy, MA to the late Lester B. and Verna M. (Bent) Sturgis.
