Obituary of Marc Micham

Marc Arlen Micham, 59, of Leesburg, Florida, died Wednesday, December 3, 2014. Born in Toledo, Ohio, he moved permanently to Leesburg in 1972. He graduated from Leesburg High School in 1973 and received his Bachelors Degree from UCF(formerly known as FTU). He taught at Leesburg High School, was manager at Chopping Block in the 80's, later started Lake Construction, then became the Facilities Construction manager for Chick-Fil-A. He was a member of Leesburg Boating Club.

He is survived by his wife, Sarah; three step sons, Colton, Pierson and Gavin Craine; mother, Bernice; brother, Mike of Ohio; sisters, Pam (Terry) Henson of NC and Penny(Mark)Bennett of Leesburg; nieces & nephews, Justin Bennett, Ashley Bryan, Jake Henson, Audrey Vandall-Henson, Karen Kovach, Chris Micham, Lauren, Lindsey and Logan Micham and several great nieces and nephews.
