Margaret Ann Hill, 82, passed away peacefully on Saturday, September 14, 2024, with her loving husband, Edmund S Hill, and family at her side in Leesburg, Florida.

Born in Pyrites, NY, on September 16, 1941, Margaret was the daughter of the late Guy and Ethel Rocca. She earned her bachelor of science degree in nursing from Suny Empire State College. She married Edmund on June 22, 1963 and moved to North Carolina while he served in the Marine Corp at Camp Lejune. Margaret's career as a nurse included Jacksonville NC hospital, Gouverneur EJ Noble Hospital and St Lawrence Public Health in Gouverneur, NY. Maggie retired in 1999. She and her husband split their time between Gouverneur and Florida, before settling fulltime in Leesburg, Florida in 2007.
