Marie Oliver of Bushnell, Florida, died Monday, April 2, 2018 at her home. She was 96. Marie was born in Gwinnett County, Georgia on May 12, 1921, the daughter of Carl Watson Johnson and the former Beatrice Hewatt.

She worked as a civilian employee of the U.S. Navy during World War II.
