Obituary of Marion Berg

Marion Berg, 83, of the Villages, died Friday, July 22, 2011. Mrs. Berg was born in Wilkes-Barre, PA and moved to The Villages from Moorestown, NJ in 1987. After graduation, she went to work for the FBI, working her way up to the Alien Enemy Registration during World War II. Later went to work for RCA in NJ, where she met her husband Bill. They owned and operated the Country Gentleman Farm Market, a family run farm and roadside farm market for 10 years. When her husband was called back to work at RCA, she became general manager for Traino's Harvest Acres Farm Market, for 11 years until they both retired to the Villages. Always an active volunteer, Marion was involved in Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts with her two sons, President and Life Member of the PTA in NJ. She loved all the activities in the Villages; but none more than her work with The Villages Regional Hospital Auxiliary, where she volunteered countless hours and received the 2004 Volunteer of the Year award. She was preceded in death by her husband William "Bill" of 35 years. Survivors include sons, Richard K. Moberg, Manchester, NH, Robert K. Moberg and wife, Cyndi, Phoenix, AZ, sister, Jean Bradley and husband John, West Chester, PA and many nieces, nephews and friends.
