December 18, 1958 - December 21, 2024

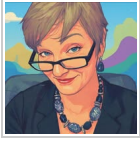

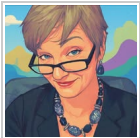


*A few different eras.*

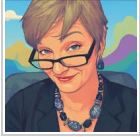
