Obituary of Martha Pardee

Martha Ann Crafts Pardee, 78, The Villages, FL died on Sunday, February 2, 2014. She was born on March 4, 1935 and moved from Waterford, CT to Orange Blossom Gardens, Lady Lake, FL in 1989.
