Obituary of Marvin Oliver

Marvin Lawton Oliver, 77, Fruitland Park, FL passed away on Saturday, May 23, 2015. Marvin was born on April 23, 1938 in Jasper, FL and was a member of Community United Methodist Church of Fruitland Park. He was a retired Communication Tech with Sprint Telephone of Florida and life long resident of the state of Florida, a graduate of Jasper High School Class of 1956, and attended Berry College in Mt.
