Mary Dusenbury Dry, 91, passed away on April 2, 2017. Mrs. Dry was born in Avon Park, FL on October 3, 1925 to Ethyle Estelle and Edwin C. Dusenbury. At the age of five, the family moved to Leesburg, FL.

Mary attended Leesburg schools and graduated from Leesburg High School with the class of 1944. After graduation, being war time, Mary went to Panama City, FL to work at Tyndall Air Force Base where she met and married her husband, Cletus Quillain Dry. They lived in Panama City until Mr. Dry's untimely death in 1962.

After Mr. Dry's death, Mary returned to Leesburg to be near family. She worked for the Lake County Health Department for several years and later worked for Paul F. Tumlin, M.D. for the next 22 years.

Mary has been a lifelong member of Morrison United Methodist Church where she sang in the choir for many years and served on several committees as well. Mary was also a member of the Leesburg Triangle Club and Women for Hospice.

Mrs. Dry is survived by her sister, Genene D. Rawls and her nephew, William C. Dusenbury, both of Leesburg.
