### Obituary of Mary Pahl

Mary E. Pahl, 89, passed Monday, February 21, 2011 at the Lake Harris Health Center in Leesburg, Florida. She died peacefully in her sleep of natural causes.

Mary was born February 24, 1921 in Jamestown, New York to Rev. John Edward Jenkins and Margaretta May Parsons. The youngest of four children, Mary was raised in Newburgh, New York, educated at Newburgh Academy, and graduated from Ohio State University with a bachelor's degree in education. Mary was an elementary school teacher in Oberlin, Ohio; Long Island, New York; and Rockville, Maryland.

She was happily married to Eugene LeRoy Pahl from June 30, 1948 until Gene's death March 27, 1995. Mary and Gene moved from Newburgh to Maryland shortly after their marriage and ultimately settled in Rockville, where they raised two sons. When Gene retired in 1977, they moved to Leesburg, Florida, living in Fruitland Park. After Gene's death, Mary moved to the Lake Port Square retirement community.

Mary was beloved by many for her kindness, loyalty, and generosity of spirit. She was dedicated to her family, faith, church activities, and volunteer service.

Mary is survived by her sons Dale of Durham, North Carolina and Dean of Salt Lake City, Utah; grandchildren Jonathan, Benjamin, Cora, and Wade; great-grandson Tobin; and five nieces.
