Obituary of Mary Taylor

Mary Ruth Taylor, born October 16, 1922 in Logan, WV died October 24, 2011 in Leesburg, FL. She was a graduate of Marshall College, earning her Bachelor's degree in education and Master's degree in Guidance. She moved to Lakeland, FL with her husband, Dan, in 1955 where she taught Physical Education at Lakeland Jr. High School. In 1962, they moved to Leesburg and she became one of the original faculty members at Lake Sumter Junior College. She was the first girls' PE instructor and cheerleading coach and later became Director of Student Activities along with Student Government Sponsor and director of the Lyceum Program which brought a broad range of entertainment and public figures to the community. When she retired in 1992, she worked with the Veterans Program.

She is survived by: daughter, JoJo Wawryk and her husband Mike; son, Frank Taylor and his wife Carol; grandchildren, Alyson Proctor Raeder and Mycha Proctor Dungan; great-grandchildren, Ethan and Elliot Raeder, Chase and Isabella Grace, CJ Wood and Tara Wood. She was preceded in death by her husband of 49 years, Dan Taylor in 1995.
