Michael John Radomski, age 29, of Wildwood, FL, formerly of Saddle Brook, NJ, tragically passed away on October 12th, 2017. Beloved husband of Christina Mae (nee Schmidgall) formerly of Golden Valley, MN. Michael was raised in Saddle Brook, NJ. He was a parishioner of St. Leo's Church in Elmwood Park. He graduated from Bergen Catholic High School, class of 2006. While a student there, he began his love of broadcasting and journalism as part of the BCTV morning show and as editor-in-chief for the school newspaper, "The Herald". He continued his education at Quinnipiac University in Hamden, CT. He earned his Bachelors of Arts Degree in Journalism in 2010.

Upon graduation, Michael began his broadcasting career in Evansville, IN. During his 5 years with the Otters, Michael was a broadcaster, an account executive, and served as media relations director. He was the longest tenured radio broadcaster in Otters franchise history, calling over 550 games.

In 2014, he became the Director of Media Relations for the University of Evansville Purple Aces, where he oversaw media aspects for women's

basketball, baseball, and men's and women's soccer. It was at UE where Michael met the love of his life, Christina. They were married in Minnesota in June 2016.

Michael moved to Tampa, FL in 2015 to work at the University of South Florida. Initially he was responsible for the athletic communications involving baseball, volleyball, and sailing for the USF Bulls. In January of 2016, he was promoted to Assistant Director of Communications and oversaw the media aspects for men's basketball, football, cross country, and track and field. Michael's infectious smile and kind heart will never be forgotten. He always made time for someone who needed help and was quick with a personal, handwritten thank you note. He was pure sunshine.
