### Obituary of MILDRED MILLNER

Mildred Stinson Millner, "Millie" to her friends, passed away peacefully at Lakeview Terrace in Altoona, FL, on December 3, 2015. She was 98 years old.

Millie is survived by her sons, Frank Howard (Irene Thomas), Dennis Howard (Jackie) and Gary Langley, grandchildren Chris, Tim and Nick Howard, and three great grandchildren.

Born and raised in southwestern Virginia, she moved to the Washington, DC area with her family as a teenager. She went to work in DC as a career secretary for the Post Office Department, and was at one time the personal secretary to Postmaster General Arthur Summerfield.

Upon retirement, Millie and her husband, Edward C. Millner, Jr., moved to Florida, first to Hawthorne, then to The Villages, and subsequently to Lakeview Terrace in 2000. They were married for 45 years; Ed preceded her in death in 2007. Millie lost her beloved sister, Irene Veihmeyer, also a Lakeview Terrace resident, in 2004.

For many years Millie was active in the Order of the Eastern Star, and she

loved activities such as golf, oil and fabric painting, and dancing. She took part in square dancing, line dancing, and even (in her 70s) tap dancing. Millie loved to 'cut a rug' at any event where there was music, space to dance, and a willing partner. At Lakeview Terrace she participated in the many activities offered there, including Wii bowling and acting in plays.

Millie was a warm, loving, gentle and sweet person, with a great sense of humor. She always had a twinkle in her eye and a smile on her face, and she was loved by all who knew her. She touched the hearts of many people throughout her life and will be missed and remembered fondly.

A service to celebrate her life will be held at 11 AM Friday, December 11, at Beyers Funeral Home in Umatilla, FL. Family will also receive friends on Thursday, 3 to 6 PM at the funeral home.

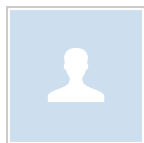
