### Obituary of Milton J. Beall

Milton James Beall, 81, of Leesburg, Florida was born August 5, 1930 in Washington, D.C. and died Sunday, March 18, 2012. Mr. Beall served in the US Army during the Korean War, transferred to the retired reserve in 1968 where he attained the rank of Captain. He attended Benjamin Franklin University in Washington, D.C. and was associated with Citizens Bank of Maryland for over 11 years and most recently with Maryland Federal Bank for over 29 years where he served as Executive Vice President, Treasurer and member of the Board of Directors until his retirement in 1990. His professional memberships included the Maryland Bankers Assoc., American Institute of Banking and Maryland League of Savings and Loans Assoc. He was loved and respected by everyone that knew him and was community minded; serving on the Board of Directors of Prince Georges Chamber of Commerce, Prince Georges Chamber of Commerce Foundation, United Cerebral Palsey of Prince Georges County, Salvation Army of Prince Georges County and the Bowie Kiwanis. Mel was also a member of the American Legion Disney-Bell Post #66 in Bowie, MD, Life Member of the Military Officers Assoc. of America and the United States Army Officers Candidate Alumni Assoc. Upon retiring in 1990 he moved to his weekend home in Montross, VA where he lived on the Potomac River for 15 years and then to Leesburg, FL. He was a member of St. Paul's Catholic Church, Leesburg, FL and Hague, VA.

He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Eileen Beall of Leesburg; sons Jim (Alicia) Beall of West River, MD; Mike (Diana) Beall of Huntingtown, MD; grandchildren Patrick, Corbin, Kelly, Rachel, Kristina, Jennifer Beall and nieces, nephews and other extended family members.
