Misty Shuatan Rhodes, 63, passed away peacefully on November 17, 2025, in Clermont, Florida. Born on February 6, 1962, in Monroe, Michigan, Misty lived a life marked by strength, devotion, and unwavering love for her family and faith.

Misty grew up in Port Washington, Wisconsin, where she graduated with the Class of 1980 from Port Washington High School. Following her years of military service, she pursued her passion for beauty and style by attending cosmetology school and earning her degree. Her natural flair for fashion and home décor became lifelong interests that she joyfully shared with those around her.

In 1980, Misty answered the call to serve her country by enlisting in the United States Marine Corps. During her four years of honorable service, she was stationed in Okinawa and at Camp Lejeune. Her extended family included numerous cousins, nieces and nephews, and close family friends with whom she shared cherished memories and meaningful connections. Misty was preceded in death by her parents: Shirley and Albert Walter Jacks. A woman of deep faith and compassion, Misty found spiritual strength in her relationship with Jesus Christ. In later years, she attended services at The Bridge Church in Linden, Florida alongside Tim whenever possible. Known for her heartfelt prayers and unwavering belief in their power, Misty was always ready to offer spiritual support to anyone who asked.

Despite facing challenges such as vision loss later in life, Misty remained resilient and full of grace. She adapted by listening to audiobooks at night—a testament to her enduring love for stories—and continued to find joy in life's simple pleasures. She had a special gift for giving—thoughtful presents that reflected how well she knew and loved those around her. Her generosity wasn't measured by size or cost but by the care behind each gesture. Her family will forever remember the warmth of her smile and the comfort of her steady presence.
