Obituary of Murray Strange

Murray Robert Strange, 85 of Lady Lake, Florida passed peacefully, Saturday, September 26, 2015, at Lady Lake Specialty Care. He was born June 16, 1930 in San Antonio, Texas. Following high school, Murray enlisted in the United States Coast Guard, where he served his country for twenty years and one day, retiring as a Warrant Officer (W2). After the Military he attended Atlanta Christian College where he received his Bachelor of Science degree in Christian Ministry, in 1976. For the next 25 years he pastored churches in Florida, Virginia, Indiana, Georgia and Alabama. After retiring from located ministry he continued to speak whenever called upon. Later he studied for and received his Boat Captains License from the Merchant Marine. He would drive a glass bottom boat at Silver Springs for the next seven years. His hobbies included motorcycling, stained glass and raising daylilies. He was also an avid sports enthusiast as well and an accomplished athlete in his younger years.

He was preceded in death by his parents James and Rosanell Strange, two sisters, three brothers, and his daughter, Melanie Strange. Mr. Strange is survived by his wife of sixty-five years, Marion, two Sons, Arthur Dale Strange and wife Carolyn of Lady Lake, FL and Caryl James Strange and wife Phyllis of Mt. Juliet, TN, seven grandchildren, eleven great grandchildren and one

sister Vida McCoy of Lewisville, Texas.
