Obituary of Nathalie Huntt

Nathalie Bingham Huntt died peacefully September 11, 2016, at age 96, after an afternoon of sharing memories with her family at the home of her son in Leesburg, Florida. Nathalie was born in Gloucester, Virginia to the former Clara Ethel Collier and Edwin Leonard Bingham. Nathalie grew up in Washington, D.C. and Bethesda Maryland. As a young woman she enjoyed tennis, ice skating and horseback riding.

Nathalie married David Greer Huntt, October 19, 1940 at the Bethesda Presbyterian Church. While her husband served in the South Pacific during WWII, Nathalie worked for the British Supply Company in Washington. Nathalie and her husband David, with their children moved to Leesburg, Florida in 1954.

Nathalie enjoyed serving at her church, the Leesburg Triangle Club and the Leesburg Women's Club. In the 1980's, Nathalie served as president of the Florida Legal Secretaries Association. Nathalie always enjoyed her friends, bridge, and various other games. She continued her two daily crossword puzzles until recent months.

protectiveness, teaching and reading stories from the Bible, prayers at night and of instilling Christian values. She was a woman of honor, gentleness, faithfulness and concern for others and was a member of The Church of Christ.

Nathalie is predeceased by her husband, David, and her grandsons Michael Hartford and John Lacefield as well as a sister Clare Pumphrey.

She is survived by her sister, Helen Pugh: daughter, Judith Nathalie Lacefield; Judith's three children and 7 granddaughters and by her son, David Lee, his wife Kathy; their 4 children, 4 grandchildren, 6 great grandchildren and 6 great great grandchildren as well as much beloved nieces and nephews.
