Obituary of Neil Duttenhaver

Neil H. Duttenhaver, 78, of Wildwood, Florida passed away Tuesday May 4, 2010. Mr. Duttenhaver was born in St. Augustine, Florida and was a State Trooper with the Florida Highway Patrol for 26 1/2 years. He moved to Leesburg from the Tampa area in 1980 and was the Commanding Officer of the Florida Highway Patrol station in Fruitland Park, Florida for 8 years, 1979-1987. He retired as Captain in 1987, and in 1998 moved to Wildwood, Florida. Mr. Duttenhaver was a veteran of the US Air Force and served in the Korean War, member of the Florida Association of State Troopers, was an avid golfer, builder and woodworker.
