Nick traveled the world, held many different jobs, and experienced life as an exciting adventure. He lived, visited, and worked in many interesting and

beautiful locations including Europe, Costa Rica, Hawaii, and many States here in the USA. As an active athlete Nick enjoyed all manner of sports and excelled in any competition he undertook. Baseball, soccer, football, lacrosse, cycling, and running were just a few of the many sports he enjoyed. Nick was tragically injured in a cycling accident in January 2012 which rendered him a quadriplegic. Nick pursued his rehabilitation and recovery with the same focused and determined attitude with which he pursued his life prior to his injury; life is short, let's live it to the full.
