Nicole M. Watson-Fassbinder, 38, of Belleview, FL died unexpectedly, on March 16th, from injuries sustained in an auto accident while traveling home with her husband Neil. This accident also claimed the life of their newborn baby girl, Niki Marie, who was born in Ocala, FL, and passed days later, The Women and Children hospital in Orlando, FL. Their loss was completely unexpected and the family is shocked and deeply saddened.

Nicole was born on April 19th 1983 to Charlotte Mauldin and Glenn Watson in Leesburg, FL. Nicole graduated from Umatilla High School and was passionate about caring for others. Before stepping away from work, to be a full-time mother, she worked at You and Your Health Family Care in Tavares, FL as a Medical Assistant.
