May 17, 1946 - April 29, 2019

Niren Laxmichand Nagda, 72, of Clarksburg, MD, died peacefully on April 29 in Tavares, Florida. Niren was born on May 17, 1946 in Mumbai, India and grew up in Khamgaon, Maharashtra. He studied chemical engineering at the Indian Institute of Technology-Mumbai, and received his PhD in environmental health from University of Illinois-Chicago after immigrating to the U.S. in 1969. He was a devoted husband and father and had a successful career as an environmental scientist specializing in indoor air quality. After retiring at age 57, he dedicated his time to studying Jainism, traveling, bicycling, and enjoying time with his grandchildren. He leaves behind his wife Jaya, who he was married to for 50 years; his son Suneel and daughter-in law Jennifer of Philadelphia, PA; his daughter Sonia and son-in law Jason Broehm of Washington, DC; his grandkids Maya, Ethan, and Bode; and his brother Anil and sisters Hansa, Kashmira, and Amita.

The funeral service will be held at Beyers Funeral Home in Leesburg, FL at 2pm on May 2.
