Obituary of Norman Bernard

Norman G. Bernard, age 84, of The Villages, Florida, passed away peacefully in his sleep on September 9, 2013 at his home.

He was born January 20, 1929 to George and Erma Bernard of Strongsville, Ohio. He was the second youngest of nine children. He graduated from Strongsville High School and enlisted in the army. He became a proud member of the 82nd Airborne Division and successfully made 13 parachute jumps, the last of which was in 1948. He was employed as an industrial pipefitter (Pipefitters Local 120) in Cleveland, Ohio and lived most of his adult life in Richfield, Ohio before retiring and moving to Florida in 1992. He loved to fish, playing cards, table tennis and dancing, and he was a member of a clogging dance club called the "Two by Fours" in Lady Lake, Florida for 8 years.

He is survived by his children Randy (Kathy) Bernard of Winter Garden, Florida, Tom (Linda) Bernard of Summerfield, North Carolina, and Debra (Brian) Roy of Medina, Ohio, as well as eight grandchildren and two grandchildren-in-law, all of whom he loved very much. He is also survived by

his youngest sister Joyce Zawacki(Jay) of Homosassa, Florida, and many nieces and nephews.
