Obituary of Onzel Bynum

Onzel (Onzie) Horton Bynum, aged 93, of Leesburg, FL passed away on March 27, 2010. She was born on June 2, 1916 in Oneonta, AL to Pentie H. and Ola S. Horton. Her father, at one time manufactured hickory auto spokes for Ford Motor Company and owned a cotton gin. Her mother was a homemaker. Onzie attended the University of Alabama. She married Edward M.
