Obituary of Osa Tilman

Osa McNeely Tilman passed away peacefully on April 13th, 2015 at the Cornerstone Hospice House in The Villages. She courageously battled leukemia for the last 20 months, her journey strengthened by her faith and optimism.

Osa was born in 1937 in Glendale, CA. Her family moved to Natchez, MS, her father's home, when she was 7. She graduated from Louisiana State University in 1958 and

met and married husband Dean in New Orleans in 1963. They raised their two sons, Matthew and Dean, in Jacksonville and after retirement moved to Destin, FL for 5 years before moving to The Villages in 2005.

Osa treasured her membership in the Villages Cheerleaders and the Silver Rockettes. She was a member of the North Lake Presbyterian Church and the Daughters of the American Revolution (Custer Co. NE). She also loved her annual trips to the Pacific beaches of Costa Rica with close friends.

Osa was blessed to have many devoted friends who were always in close touch with her throughout her cancer journey. She enjoyed playing golf and participating in dance and exercise classes as well as reading and listening to music every day. Traveling and taking cruises with friends were also a highlight of her life.

Osa is survived by her beloved husband of 51 years, Dean Tilman III, and their two sons Dean IV (his wife Cathy), Matthew (his wife Barbie), and their five cherished grandchildren Gracie, Nickel, Lucy, Pressly, and Lila. She also leaves behind her brother Tom McNeely, half brothers Don and Joe McNeely, and half sister Jaime Graham.

A memorial service will be held at North Lake Presbyterian Church in The Villages on Wednesday April 22nd at 11am followed by a Celebration of Life at The Waterfront Inn. In lieu of flowers the family is requesting that donations be made to the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society or a charity of one's choice.
