### Obituary of Paul Boris

PAUL A. BORIS, 91, of The Villages, Florida, died Wednesday, July 27, 2011. He was born May 24, 1920 in Brooklyn, New York. He moved to The Villages in 1992 from Ellington, CT. He was a retired Aeronautical Engineer with Pratt & Whitney Corporation with 40 years of service. He was the program engineer on the Pratt & Whitney JT8D Turbofan Engine Project. The JT8D Turbofan Engine is the most popular & widely used turbofan engine in aviation history & is still in production today & used by more than 175 airlines worldwide. Mr. Boris was a U.S. Army veteran serving during WWII, a member of the Elmcrest Country Club, East Longmeadow, MA, The Villages Irish American Club, The Connecticut Club and The Hole-In-One Club. He enjoyed golf, cooking, gardening, listening to music, the theatre & arts; he was a published poet & enjoyed spending time with his wife, children, grandchildren and friends.
