Obituary of PAUL NOE

Paul Noe, 87, of Umatilla, Florida passed into eternal life September 16, 2011. He was born January 19, 1924 to Carl Hezekiah Noe and Margaret Stevens Noe in Welch, WV. He is preceded in death by four brothers and five sisters. He is the last surviving sibling of his generation. He was also preceded by his son Carl Paul Noe and grandson, Carl Paul Noe, Jr. Paul was a member of the United States Army and served during World War II. He was a member of the 125th AAA Gun Battalion/Battery D. He served in England, France, Belgium, Holland and Germany. Paul was a Coal Miner for 25 years with Semet Solvey in Tralee and Havaco, WV. He was a member of the United Mine Workers of America. Paul married Belle Noe on November 30, 1943 and lived in Princeton, WV until 1976 when he moved his family to Umatilla, FL. He was a volunteer and employee of Christian Home & Bible School in Mount Dora FL for many years. Paul was inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame at Christian Home & Bible School, receiving a meritorious award. He was a member of the Orange Ave. Church of Christ in Eustis, FL. He is survived by his wife Belle of 67 years.
