Paul E. Rosselle passed away on Tuesday, November 23, 2021 at age 97. Born in Key West, FL, he moved to Miami, FL at the age of 6. He graduated from Miami Senior High School and attended the University of Miami. He worked for his father, the founder of Roselle's Metals, established in 1918.

Paul was a longtime member of The Gideon's International and a member of Riverside Methodist Church in Miami. He moved to Altoona, FL in 1995 and became a member of the Eustis First Baptist Church. Later he joined the Umatilla First Baptist Church. Throughout his life he taught Sunday School and worked with young people. Paul was also active in the Boy Scouts of America.

He is survived by his wife Eleanor Rosselle; his four sons, Bob, Bill, Jim and Dan Rosselle and their spouses; His wife's children, Mark Crutchfield, Dan Crutchfield and his spouse and Carol Sifflinger. He had a large number of grandchildren and great grandchildren.
