Pedro I. Ramos, 73, cherished husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle and friend to all who met him, was lost to us on July 12, 2011. Seeking the liberty and freedom of the United States, Pedro bravely fled his home country of Cuba in 1964 to join his beautiful wife Velia and their first born son here in Florida. Together he and Velia raised their three children Israel, Beatriz and Alex in Orlando and owned and operated the family business, Pedro's Auto Repair, for over 40 years. He was a pillar in the close-knit Cuban community which was growing in Orlando in the early '60's; and that community of family and friends has always been and continues to be a great source of comfort and support to his family. After retiring, Pedro and Velia recently moved to Howey-in-the-Hills, to be closer to their grandchildren, Katelyn, Israel, Sydney and Simon Ramos. Pedro always had a funny story to tell and treasured every day living his life to the fullest.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be Monday, July 18, 2011 at 10:00 AM at St. James Catholic Cathedral, Orlando with Father John McCormick Celebrant. A private family interment will be at Taylor Cemetery, Howey-In-The-Hills, FL.
