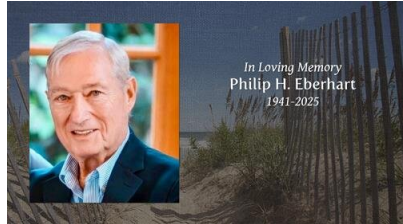
A celebration of Phil's life will be held in Ohio and will be announced at a later date.
