Obituary of Porter Saltus

Porter E. Saltus, 89, of Summerfield, Florida passed away Sunday, June 21, 2015. He was born in Burlington, Vermont to Lucy and John Saltus.

Porter served 36 years in the U.S. Military beginning in World War II with a four year enlistment in the U.S. Navy. He left the Navy as a Gunner's Mate Second Class and returned home to Vermont where he joined the Navy Reserves and later, the Army National Guard. Porter retired from the United States Army as Chief Warrant Officer Four in 1985.

Porter is survived by his loving wife of 35 years, Bobby Bulen Saltus, his three sons; Steven, Thomas and Mark, and 13 grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his daughter Debbie Daudlin.

Porter was a talented golfer or could be found in his wood working shop making beautiful pieces of art through his ability to craft wood. He was also an expert marksman and was recognized along with his Vermont National Guard team for competing in the 1964 NRA - National Rifle and Pistol Championship

held annually in Camp Perry, Ohio.
