



Ralph Leon Cook

November 25, 1932 - August 11, 2021

Ralph L. Cook, age 88, went home to be with his Lord on August 11, 2021 in Eustis, Florida. Ralph was born in Taylor, Texas in 1932. The son of Emil and Mary Cook, Ralph and his brother Charles (d.1993) were brought up on the Christian liturgies of the Lutheran Church and a strong work ethic. After graduating from Texas Lutheran College in 1953, Ralph pursued a lifelong career in banking and real estate in the Corpus Christi area until he retired in 2010. Ralph spent over 60 years as a commercial property appraiser in Texas and was a member of the development and corporate board of his alumnus college. Throughout his entire life, Ralph served as lay minister, councilman, choir member, and faithful friend in his church. In 2020, Ralph left his long-time home of Corpus Christi, TX and moved to Florida.

Ralph is survived by his three sons (Rolean Cook): R. Duane (Katherine), Troy (Laurie) and Richard Cook. In 1986, Ralph wed Diane (d. 2020) and leaves behind his beloved step-daughters Holly, Heather and Hope (David). Ralph never failed to express his great pride, support and love for his children, his thirteen grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren.
