### Obituary of Ray Robbins

Ray Robbins, 96, died Sunday as a result of a stroke. Raised in the historic Tuscanooga community, near Groveland, Robbins is survived by his wife, Etta, of 74 years and 10 months. He is also survived by daughter-in-law Bernice Robbins, wife of deceased son, Charles, and daughter, Mary Helen (Wally) Myers, all of Tuscanooga. He had 7 grandchildren: Denise Kurfiss, Becky Brown, Anthony Myers, all of Groveland; Patricia Brown, Leesburg; Missy Yates, Mascotte; Wallace "Hoss" Myers, Orlando; Margie Ritchey, Windermere, and 14 great grandchildren.

A "Legendary Local of Lake County," Robbins began his work career as the first employee of Sumter Electric (SECO), from which he retired and later served as Chairman of the Board of Directors. For years he Chaired the Lake County Planning and Zoning Commission, was a past President of Rotary and Farm Bureau, and was the oldest living member of Tuscanooga Baptist Church. Gardening was his hobby and many area residents were recipients of his fresh vegetables.
