### Obituary of Rex Gentry

Rex Gentry, 77, of Bushnell, Florida, died Tuesday, September 28, 2010 at St. Petersburg, FL. He was born February 13, 1933 in Cookeville, Tennessee. He was a Veteran of the United States Navy and served during the Korean Conflict and was a Naval Photographer. He was the former Advertising Director for the Sumter County Times from 1956 - 1963. He also worked in Insurance and Real Estate and in the Elderly Care Business. He was the past president of the Bushnell Jaycees. He was a Scout Master in Cookeville, TN and a Scout Leader in Ft. Myers. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Cookeville, TN, the First Baptist Church of Bushnell, Bushnell, FL, and the First Assembly and Faith Assembly in Ft. Myers, FL where he served as a Deacon.

He is survived by his wife, Carolyn Hamilton Gentry of Bushnell; son, Guy Gentry of Ft. Myers; brothers, Ronald Gentry of Inverness, Ross Gentry of Virginia, and Randy Gentry of Iraq and Alabama. He was preceded in death by his brother Conrad Gentry.
